Venue

Nowy Gierałtów is a picturesquely situated village at the foot of Rudawiec (1106 m) where the reserve is located. Extensive terrain with high tourist, skiing and nature values. The village can be safely called a different world: remote, peaceful, picturesque, quiet, ideal for relaxation. Nowy Gierałtów is also interesting because of its inhabitants who are often folk artists cultivating dying out traditions. The area encourages hiking, cycling, there is also a ski lift and the whole is complemented by a wonderful mountain climate. The village is mainly focused on tourism and this is obvious, because its qualities are undeniable.

Transfers to the venue

The closest airport and biggest train station are in Wrocław which is about 120 km away from the venue (ab. 2 hours by car).

There is a possibility to take a bus from the airport to the city centre and then a train or a bus from Wrocław to Stronie Śląskie (a town about 8km away from the village). We can pick you up from Stronie Śląskie.



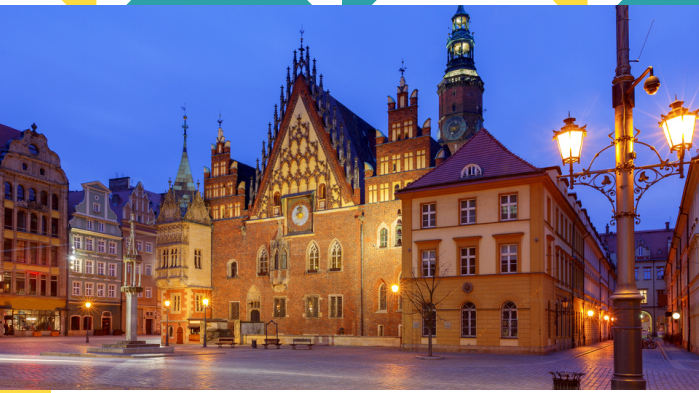
Should there be a larger group of participants arriving closely in time, direct transportation from the airport to the venue might be organized (please, consider this potential cost as it shall be covered from the participant travel lump sum).

Before the start of the project, participants will be informed about the options and suggestions.

The programme starts on 18th and finishes on 24th therefore, you should arrive on Sunday 18th early morning latest and plan departing on Sunday 24th after farewell ceremony soonest.

If you wish to visit Wrocław touristically, we strongly advise that you arrive 1-2 days ahead of time or stay 1-2 days after the course to visit this beautiful and vibrant student city.
